

# Remote Learning Protocols



## Parent Responsibilities

- Provide an environment conducive to learning (access to technology, safe and quiet space during the day)
- Collect appropriate technology from school (by appointment)
- Encourage and support your child to complete their assigned remote learning tasks set by their teacher
- Practice a growth mindset – we are learning together in this new space
- Communicate to teacher/school if they are not able to be present online
- Seek support from Thomastown Primary School if and when required
- Communicate with teachers, through Class Dojo during school hours (9-3pm)
- Communicate appropriately (with respect, courtesy and an understanding of appropriate frequency) with teachers, understanding that teachers are expected to communicate with many families and cannot respond instantly
- Read with your child daily

## Student Responsibilities

- Use technology responsibly – following the Cyber Safety and ICT Guidelines
- Check Class Dojo daily and respond to the daily task set by the teacher
- Communicate tasks and discuss with parents
- Submit online tasks by set date
- Talk to your class teacher through Class Dojo if unsure of a task
- Complete your work to the best of your ability
